Fees

- For **day vendors** (who do not have a regular booth at the market), the fee is \$42.50 per event.
- For **seasonal vendors** (who have already paid a seasonal fee for the market), the fee is \$30.
- Fees are payable by check or cash at the time the application is submitted.
- Fees will be waived for any vendors donating their profits to the market.

What to Expect When You Arrive

- A tent and two tables will be provided at the start of market. While in the past we provided utensils, dishes and supplies, *we will not be providing those things this year.* We encourage vendors to carefully consider packaging choices so that we don't add more plastic to the landfill! - When the market is over, please wipe down tables.
- Please pack out your trash and recycling at the end of the market.

Chelsea Farmers Market Policies Regarding Prepared Foods

- Sellers of prepared foods must follow state health laws, and each vendor is responsible for any licensing or certification required for products sold. Please refer to this link for more information:

- Vendors who sell prepared food are exempt from needing a permit or facilities inspection as long as they **do NOT vend more often than one time per month**.
- A vendor who wishes to sell prepared food at the market **more frequently than one time per month** is subject to proper licensing, permitting and regulations.
- **ALL MEAT** sold at the market - cooked, fresh, or frozen - must be USDA inspected.
- Liability insurance is the vendor's responsibility.
- All food sold at CFM should be grown, raised, cooked, or prepared in VT whenever possible.

Rainy-Day Policy

- If the forecast is for severe weather, we will cancel the market by noon the day of. You will be notified via email or phone.
- If the forecast predicts a significant chance of a severe storm and we have not canceled the market, you are permitted to skip the market if you feel that it would be unsafe for you to attend, or that the risk to your merchandise is too great. If this is the case, please notify us by 12 noon, on the day of the market.
- In the event of a severe storm arriving while the market is happening, vendors may pack up early or move inside until the storm passes.
